

Mr. Pawlik is a holder of a higher education diploma, who also completed postgraduate Executive MBA studies at the Institute of Economic Sciences of the Polish Academy of Sciences. For over a dozen years he has been dealing with public transport with particular emphasis on rail transport. In recent years, he has worked on the side of regional rail passenger transport operator, and before that he was involved in: purchase of rolling stock, works related to the creation of the Poznań metropolitan railway, implementation of the so-called Bus-Tram-Railway ticket, coordinated work on the Plan for Sustainable Development of Public Collective Transport for the Wielkopolska Region.
