Contents of the Report:

With reference to Current Report No. 33/2025 of 6 November 2025 on the selection of the offer submitted by TORPOL S.A. [Issuer, Company], as the leader of a consortium composed of: the Issuer (consortium leader) and MIRBUD S.A. (consortium partner) [collectively: Consortium], as part of an open tender entitled: Preparation of detailed documentation and implementation of construction works, as part of the projects: "Works on the E 75 railway line (Rail Baltica) on the Białystok – Knyszyn section", "Works on the E 75 railway line (Rail Baltica) on the Knyszyn – Osowiec section", "Works on the E75 railway line (Rail Baltica) on the Osowiec – Ełk section", the Company's Management Board hereby announces that by its judgment of 19 January 2026, the National Chamber of Appeal partially upheld the appeal filed by one of the bidders, ordering PKP Polskie Linie Kolejowe S.A. [Ordering Party] to invalidate the selection of the Consortium's offer as the most advantageous in the above-mentioned procedure and to conduct a re-examination and evaluation of the offers, and as part of this action - to reject the Consortium's offer.

At the same time, the Issuer informs that the Consortium will analyze the justification of the judgment of the National Appeal Chamber and, based on the results of the analysis, will decide whether to file a complaint to the court against the judgment of the National Appeal Chamber.
